## Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2000/40 of 15 February 2000, S/2000/40/Add.1 of 21 February 2000, S/2000/40/Add.5 of 28 March 2000, S/2000/40/Add.8 of 14 April 2000, S/2000/40/Add.9 of 19 April 2000 and S/2000/40/Add.15 of 23 May 2000.

During the week ending 1 July 2000, the Security Council took action on the following items:

**The situation in East Timor** (*see* S/11593/Add.50 and 51; S/11935/Add.15 and 16; S/1999/25/Add.17, 22, 25, 30, 33-36, 42 and 50; and S/2000/40/Add.4, 11, 16 and 20)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4165th meeting, held on 27 June 2000, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Australia, Brazil, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal and the Republic of Korea, at their request, to participate in the discussion of the item without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Sergio Vieira de Mello, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Transitional Administrator for East Timor.

**The situation in Somalia** (*see* S/23370/Add.11, 16, 30, 34 and 48; S/25070/Add.12, 23, 38, 43 and 46; S/1994/20/Add.4, 21, 33, 38 and 43; S/1995/40/Add.13; S/1996/15/Add.3, 10 and 50; S/1997/40/Add.8, 16 and 51; and S/1999/25/Add.20 and 44; *see also* S/23370/Add.3)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4166th and 4167th meetings, held on 29 June 2000 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.



At the 4166th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Djibouti, Egypt, Ethiopia, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Portugal and Yemen, at their request, to participate in the discussion of the item without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Kieran Prendergast, Under-Secretary-General for Political Affairs.

In response to a request contained in a letter dated 21 June 2000 from the Permanent Representative of Tunisia to the United Nations (S/2000/623), the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Dr. Hussien Hassouna, Permanent Observer of the League of Arab States to the United Nations.

At the 4167th meeting, held on the same date, the President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2000/22; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-fifth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2000*).
