Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2000/40 of 15 February 2000, S/2000/40/Add.1 of 21 February 2000, S/2000/40/Add.5 of 28 March 2000, S/2000/40/Add.8 of 14 April 2000, S/2000/40/Add.9 of 19 April 2000, S/2000/40/Add.15 of 23 May 2000 and S/2000/40/Add.28 of 31 July 2000.

During the week ending 16 September 2000, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation in Somalia (*see* S/23370/Add.11, 16, 30, 34 and 48; S/25070/Add.12, 23, 38, 43 and 46; S/1994/20/Add.4, 21, 33, 38 and 43; S/1995/40/Add.13; S/1996/15/Add.3, 10 and 50; S/1997/40/Add.8, 16 and 51; S/1999/25/Add.20 and 44; and S/2000/40/Add.25; *see also* S/23370/Add.3)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4196th meeting, held in private on 14 September 2000 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the meeting, the following communiqué was issued by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council:

“At its 4196th meeting, held in private on 14 September 2000, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Somalia’.

“His Excellency Mr. Ismail Omar Guelleh, President of the Republic of Djibouti, was invited to participate in the discussion.

“The Security Council heard a briefing by His Excellency Mr. Ismail Omar Guelleh, during which, among other things, he requested the Council to give serious consideration to a United Nations post-conflict peace-building mission in Somalia.



“The members of the Council made comments and posed questions in connection with the briefing.

“Mr. Ismail Omar Guelleh responded to the comments and questions posed by members of the Council.”

The situation between Eritrea and Ethiopia (*see* S/1998/44/Add.25; S/1999/25/Add.3, 5 and 7; and S/2000/40/Add.18, 19, 30 and 32)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4197th meeting, held on 15 September 2000 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on Ethiopia and Eritrea (S/2000/785).

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2000/867) that had been prepared in the course of the Council’s prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2000/867, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1320 (2000) (for the text, see S/RES/1320 (2000); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-fifth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2000*).
