**Letter dated 29 January 2001 from the Secretary-General  
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1336 (2001), adopted by the Security Council on 23 January 2001, by which the mandate of the monitoring mechanism established pursuant to resolution 1295 (2000) was extended for a period of three months, that is, until 19 April 2001. In paragraph 5 of that resolution the Council requested that, after consultation with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993), I reappoint up to five of the experts to the monitoring mechanism.

Accordingly, having consulted with the Committee, I wish to inform you that I have reappointed the following experts:

Christine Gordon (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)  
Juan Larrain (Chile)  
James Manzou (Zimbabwe)  
Ismaila Seck (Senegal)  
Lena Sundh (Sweden)

I have also requested Ambassador Juan Larrain to continue to chair the monitoring mechanism.
