LETTER DATED 18 DECEMBER 1975 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit herewith the text of resolution 3376 (XXX),* entitled "Question of Palestine", which was adopted by the General Assembly at its 2399th plenary meeting on 10 November 1975.

In this connexion, I would like to draw your attention in particular to operative paragraph 8, which reads as follows:

"Requests the Security Council to consider, as soon as possible after 1 June 1976, the question of the exercise by the Palestine people of the inalienable rights recognized in paragraphs 1 and 2 of resolution 3236 (XXIX)".

I should be most grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
