ANNEX

Declaration issued on 26 July 1988 by the Twelve on the occasion
of the Jakarta informal meeting

The Twelve welcome the Jakarta informal meeting and reiterate their support for the efforts, in particular, of the ASEAN countries, in search of a comprehensive political settlement of the problem of Kampuchea, in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the United Nations.

They hope that the meeting will be a starting point for a peace process that will lead to the restoration of a sovereign, independent, neutral and non-aligned Kampuchea. To this end, the total withdrawal of all Vietnamese forces from Kampuchea is indispensable.
