

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan

Letter dated 19 February 2001 from the Royal Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the Chairman of the Committee

Measures imposed to implement Security Council resolution 1333 (2000)

With reference to your letter of 19 January 2001 in which you refer to paragraph 20 of Security Council resolution 1333 (2000) wherein all States were requested to report to the Committee on the steps taken to effectively implement Council resolution 1333 (2000), we wish to inform as follows.

In order to take the necessary steps to implement Security Council resolution 1333 (2000), Denmark, along with the other members of the European Union (EU), will issue a Common Position concerning additional restrictive measures against the Taliban. In addition, Denmark, along with our EU partners, will issue a Council Regulation prohibiting the exportation of certain goods and services to Afghanistan, strengthening the flight ban and freezing funds and other financial resources in respect of the Taliban of Afghanistan as stipulated in Council resolution 1333 (2000). The Common Position and the Council Regulation are under preparation and are expected to be issued soon.

As soon as the Common Position and the Council Regulation have been approved, the Danish Government will take steps to ensure that those measures of the resolution that may not be covered by the Council Regulation will be implemented by a Royal Decree.
