Resumed organizational session for 2001 3-4 May 2001 Agenda item 2 Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

> Draft decision submitted by the President of the Council, Martin Belinga-Eboutou (Cameroon), on the basis of informal consultations

Information and Communication Technologies Task Force

The Economic and Social Council, recalling the ministerial declaration¹ on development and international cooperation in the twenty-first century: the role of information technology in the context of a knowledge-based global economy, adopted by the Council at its substantive session of 2000 and Council resolution 2000/29 of 28 July 2000:

(a) Takes note with appreciation of the report of the Secretary-General;²

(b) Requests the Secretary-General to undertake the necessary steps to establish the Information and Communication Technologies Task Force, in consultation with the regional groups, as recommended in the above-mentioned report taking into account the views expressed by Member States;

(c) Also requests the Secretary-General to submit a report on the implementation of the present decision to the Economic and Social Council at its substantive session of 2001.
