QUESTION OF EAST TIMOR

Note verbale dated 4 April 1978 from the Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his note dated 15 December 1977, has the honour to inform him of the following:

During 1977, the conditions prevailing in Timor as described in the note dated 20 April 1977 (A/32/73), still persisted. Owing to those circumstances, the Portuguese Government is $\underline{\text{de facto}}$ prevented from transmitting any information under Article 73 $\underline{\text{e}}$ of the Charter concerning that Territory.

The Permanent Representative of Portugal has the honour to request that this note be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly under items 93 and 95 of the preliminary list.
