**Security Council Committee established pursuant
to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan****Note verbale dated 27 March 2001 from the Permanent Mission
of Sweden to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman
of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of Sweden to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999), and referring to his note dated 19 January 2001, has the honour to communicate the following information concerning the implementation of United Nations sanctions against Afghanistan, as established by the Security Council in its resolution 1333 (2000).

The Council of the European Union, following the adoption of its common position of 26 February 2001, adopted on 6 March 2001 a regulation that prohibits the export of certain goods and services to Afghanistan, strengthens the flight ban and extends the freeze of funds and other financial resources in respect of the Taliban of Afghanistan, and repeals its previous regulation on this subject, in accordance with Security Council resolution 1333 (2000). The said regulation, which is enclosed for your information, has been in force since 10 March 2001.*

This Council regulation is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in Sweden.
