NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. In accordance with the decision taken by the Security Council at its 1853rd meeting, held on 6 November 1975, the President of the Security Council addressed, on its behalf, the following appeal to His Majesty, King Hassan II, of Morocco:

"The Security Council has authorized me to address to Your Majesty an urgent request to put an end forthwith to the declared march into Western Sahara."

2. In reply to this appeal, the President of the Security Council received early in the morning of 6 November, the following cable from His Majesty, King Hassan II, of Morocco:

"We have duly received your message relating to the communications which the Security Council had instructed you to transmit to us concerning the green march into our Sahara.

"We can only inform you that the march has in fact already begun this morning.

"We request you to renew to the Security Council the assurance repeatedly given by the Kingdom of Morocco that the march will at no time deviate from the peaceful character which underlies this action and which will be maintained throughout its course."
