Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 127 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in document A/55/691 and Add.1.

2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 55th meeting, on 30 March 2001. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/55/SR.55).

3. For its further consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting the report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the audit and investigation of the International Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (A/54/120).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/55/L.52

4. At the 55th meeting, on 30 March, the representative of Norway, coordinator of the informal consultations on this item, introduced a draft decision entitled "Report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the audit and investigation of the International Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia" (A/C.5/55/L.52), which was submitted by the Chairman on the basis of informal consultations.



5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/55/L.52 without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:
