

Letter dated 30 March 2001 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the President of the General Assembly

I have the honour to transmit the text of resolution 1347 (2001), adopted unanimously by the Security Council at its 4307th meeting, held on 30 March 2001.

Resolution 1347 (2001) reads as follows:

"The Security Council,

"Recalling its resolutions 955 (1994) of 8 November 1994, 1165 (1998) of 30 April 1998 and 1329 (2000) of 30 November 2000,

"Having considered the nominations for judges of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda received by the Secretary-General,

"Forwards the following nominations to the General Assembly in accordance with article 12, paragraph 2 (d), of the Statute of the International Tribunal:

Mr. Frederick Mwela Chomba (Zambia)

Mr. Winston Churchill Matanzima Maqutu (Lesotho)

Mr. Harris Michael Mtegha (Malawi)

Ms. Arlette Ramaroson (Madagascar)"
