ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAN AND IRAQ

REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF OPERATIVE PARAGRAPH 2 OF SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 598 (1987) (S/20093)

THE PRESIDENT (interpretation from Chinese): On behalf of the Security Council, I invite the representatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran and Iraq to take places at the Council table.

At the invitation of the President, Mr. Mahallati (Islamic Republic of Iran) and Mr. Kittani (Iraq) took places at the Council table.

THE PRESIDENT (interpretation from Chinese): The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on the agenda.

The Council is meeting today, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's consultations, to consider the report (S/20093) of the Secretary-General on the implementation of operative paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution 598 (1987).

Members of the Council have before them document S/20097, which contains the text of a draft resolution prepared in the Council's consultations.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. If I hear no objection, I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

There being no objection, it is so decided.
