LETTER DATED 9 AUGUST 1988 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED  
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 8 (c) of my report (S/20093) of 7 August 1988 on the implementation of paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution 598 (1987), in which I said that I had already instituted consultations with the parties about the composition of the United Nations Iran-Iraq Military Observer Group (UNIIMOG) and hoped very shortly to be in a position to bring this matter to the Council's attention.

Having now completed my consultations with the parties, I propose that the Group be composed of contingents from the following Member States:

Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bangladesh, Canada, Denmark, Finland, Ghana, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Kenya, Malaysia, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Poland, Senegal, Sweden, Turkey, Yugoslavia, Zambia.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
