Draft proposals submitted by the delegation of Iraq on document A/CONF.192/PC/L.4/Rev.1

Preamble

Paragraph 10

Recalling the obligations of States to fully comply with arms embargoes decided by the Security Council in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations,

Section II At the national level

Paragraph 14

To take the necessary domestic measures, including legal or administrative means, against any activity that violates a Security Council arms embargo decided in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations.

Section II At the global level

Paragraph 31

To cooperate with the United Nations system to ensure the effective implementation of arms embargoes decided by the Security Council in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations.
