Letter dated 24 April 2001 from the Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 164 unexploded cluster bombs, missiles, other ordnance and anti-personnel and antitank mines left behind by the 1991 30-nation aggression against Iraq were found and rendered harmless in all parts of Iraq in the period from 1 February to 31 March 2001. The detonation of one such bomb killed eight children in the Faw area.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
