SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/15560 of 11 January 1983 and S/15560/Add.8 of 3 March 1983.

During the week ending 26 March 1983, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Letter dated 16 March 1983 from the Permanent Representative of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 16 March 1983 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/15643), the representative of Chad requested that an urgent meeting of the Security Council be convened to consider the extremely serious situation prevailing in Chad as a result of the occupation of a part of Chad territory by the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

The Security Council considered the item at its 2419th meeting, held on 22 March 1983. The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Chad, Egypt, the Ivory Coast, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Senegal and the Sudan, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

Letter dated 22 March 1983 from the representative of Nicaragua on the Security Council addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 22 March 1983 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/15651), the representative of Nicaragua on the Security Council

requested that a meeting of the Security Council be convened as a matter of urgency to analyse the situation endangering international peace in view of the grave increase in acts of aggression against Nicaragua.

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 2420th meeting, held on 23 March 1983. The Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2421st to 2423rd meetings, on 24 to 25 March 1983.

In the course of the meetings, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Argentina, Barbados, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Democratic Yemen, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, the Federal Republic of Germany, Grenada, Honduras, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Mauritius, Mexico, Panama, Peru, the Philippines, Spain, the United Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela, Viet Nam and Yugoslavia, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
