SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/15560 of 11 January 1983, S/15560/Add.8 of 3 March 1983 and S/15560/Add.12 of 31 March 1983.

During the week ending 2 April 1983, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Letter dated 22 March 1983 from the representative of Nicaragua on the Security Council addressed to the President of the Security Council

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2424th to 2427th meetings, held on 28 and 29 March 1983. In the course of the meetings, in addition to the representatives invited previously, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czechoslovakia, El Salvador, Ghana, the German Democratic Republic, Guatemala, Hungary, Italy, Mongolia, the Syrian Arab Republic, and Uruguay, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

Letter dated 16 March 1983 from the Permanent Representative of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2428th and 2429th meetings, held on 31 March 1983. In the course of the meetings, in addition to the representatives invited previously, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Benin, Democratic Yemen, Ethiopia, Gabon, Ghana, Guinea, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Niger, the Syrian Arab Republic and the United Republic of Cameroon, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
