INFORMATION CIRCULAR NO. 21

Subject: World Health Assembly - WHO

International Labour Conference - ILO

- 1. The fifty-fourth session of the World Health Assembly and the eighty-ninth session of the International Labour Conference will be held at the Palais des Nations from 14 to 22 May and 4 to 21 June 2001, respectively.
- 2. High-ranking officials and many delegates will be attending these events at the United Nations Office at Geneva. Vehicular and pedestrian access to and movement within the Palais grounds are likely to be difficult.

During each of these sessions, some parts of the Palais will be designated as "high-security areas".

- 3. Some car parks will be reserved for the above conferences, as follows:
 - from 14 to 22 May: All of P-3 and P-5 (lower)
 - from 4 to 21 June: All of P-3 and P-5 (lower)
- 4. The arrangements for access to the Palais will not change:

The Pregny gate will be open 24 hours a day.

The railway gate will be open between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on working days only.

The Place des Nations gate will remain closed to vehicles, but the pedestrian entrance will be open between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

5. It would be appreciated if everyone would cooperate by complying with the traffic signs and the instructions of the Security and Safety Section.
