

Letter dated 30 May 2001 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1348 (2001), adopted by the Council on 19 April 2001, in which the mandate of the monitoring mechanism established pursuant to resolution 1295 (2000) was extended for a period of six months, that is to say, until 19 October 2001. In paragraph 5 of resolution 1348 (2001), the Council requested that, after consultation with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993), I appoint up to five experts to serve on the monitoring mechanism.

Accordingly, and having consulted with the Committee, I wish to inform you that I have reappointed the following four experts:

Ms. Christine Gordon (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) Ambassador Juan Larrain (Chile)

Mr. Ismaila Seck (Senegal)

Ambassador Lena Sundh (Sweden)

I have also requested Ambassador Juan Larrain (Chile) to continue to chair the monitoring mechanism.

Efforts to identify a fifth expert are continuing. Once the fifth candidate has been identified, I will act accordingly.
