LETTER DATED 28 AUGUST 1979 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF LEBANON TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to our letters of 6 and 24 August 1979 (S/13488 and S/13516) and following our meeting of yesterday 27 August 1979, I am instructed by my Government to request a meeting of the Security Council at the earliest possible date.

We are aware that there is on the terrain a <u>de facto</u> cease-fire which has been reached locally through the efforts of the United Nations Secretariat and of UNIFIL's Commander. We think that an early meeting of the Security Council, by taking notice of this cease-fire, will help consolidate it and pave the way for a further implementation of the Security Council resolutions in particular resolution 450 (1979).

I have presented today to the Secretary-General a memorandum* and I hope you will find it possible to submit this memorandum to the Council's attention.
