Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan

Note verbale dated 11 June 2001 from the Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) and has the honour to communicate the following information regarding the implementation of United Nations sanctions on Afghanistan, as established by Security Council resolution 1333 (2000).

The Council of the European Union adopted on 6 March 2001 regulation 467/2001 prohibiting the export of certain goods and services to Afghanistan, strengthening the flight ban and extending the freeze of funds and other financial resources in respect of the Taliban of Afghanistan, in accordance with Security Council resolution 1333 (2000). This regulation is directly applicable in the Portuguese legal order.

All Ministries and public departments involved in the implementation of the measures imposed by Security Council resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1333 (2000) were duly informed of their obligations, in particular the Ministries of Finance, Economy, Defence and Internal Affairs and the Bank of Portugal and the National Institute for Civil Aviation (Ministry of Equipment).
