PETITION FROM DR. NOBUO KUSANO, DIRECTOR GENERAL, CONFERENCE OF  
JAPAN COUNCIL AGAINST AH BOMBS (GENSUIKYO), CONCERNING THE  
TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS

Following decision of 1982 World Conference Against Ah Bombs Tokyo 2 August, Nagasaki follow-up action Conference of Japan Council Against Ah Bombs (GENSUIKYO) 8 August recommends this cable sent to you. We request Trusteeship Council the following: firstly, terminate pre-independence Trusteeship Agreement 1/ with United States of America in order that Belau nuclear-free Constitution be respected by the latter. Secondly, allow Marshalese self-determination and establish their sovereign state and also allow Kwajalein displace natives fully rehabilitated and their right restored to live in peace in their homeland which is being used as missile targeting range by United States against their will. Thirdly, allow Northern Mariana Commonwealth to be fully independent from United States with unrestricted claim on military matters and guarantee it to be nuclear-free accepting Mariana natives' refusal of Air Force base reconstruction on Tinian Island.
