Note verbales dated 17 July 2001 from the Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia and, with reference to the note dated 7 June 2001, has the honour to inform him of the following:

1. Concerning the restrictive measures against Liberia imposed by resolution 1343 (2001), the Council of the European Union has adopted Regulation No. 1146/2001, directly applicable in Portugal.
2. The provisions of resolution 1343 (2001) have been brought to the attention of the relevant Portuguese authorities and public entities, namely the Ministries of Finance, Economy, Defence, Internal Affairs and the Bank of Portugal.
