The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia and, referring to his note dated 7 June 2001, has the honour, in addition to the information contained in the note verbale of the Bulgarian Mission dated 25 June 2001 addressed to the Chairman of the Committee, to communicate the following:

With regard to the embargo on exports of arms and related materiel of all types and the provision of technical training related to the provision, manufacture, maintenance or use of such equipment (Security Council resolution 1343 (2001, para. 5)), the Government of the Republic of Bulgaria adopted a special decree in May 2001, by which it approved the restrictive regime on certain countries, including Liberia.

In keeping with the efforts undertaken by the Bulgarian State until now, the newly formed Government is preparing a draft decree, which will further widen the scope of the decree adopted in May 2001.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bulgaria would appreciate it if the present note verbale were to be issued as a document of the Security Council.
