## Explanatory memorandum

- 1. The Third Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons was held at Geneva from 27 August to 21 September 1985, under the Presidency of Mr. Mohamed Shaker of Egypt.
- 2. In the Final Document of the Third Review Conference, the States parties to the Treaty proposed to the Depositary Governments that a fourth conference to review the operation of the Treaty be convened in 1990. The Conference accordingly invited the States parties to the Treaty which are members of the United Nations to request the Secretary-General to include the following item in the agenda of the forty-third session of the General Assembly: "Implementation of the conclusions of the Third Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and establishment of a preparatory committee for the Fourth Review Conference".
- 3. In accordance with this proposal, the Governments named below request inclusion of this item on the agenda of the forty-third session of the General Assembly.
