**Security Council Committee established pursuant
to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia****Note verbale dated 23 August 2001 from the Permanent
Mission of Ireland to the United Nations addressed to the
Chairman of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of Ireland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia and, with reference to his note verbale of 7 June 2001 and pursuant to paragraph 18 of Security Council resolution 1343 (2001), requesting all States to report to the Committee established by paragraph 14 of said resolution on the steps they have taken to implement the measures imposed under its paragraphs 5 to 7, Ireland has the honour to communicate the following information.

By adopting Common Position 2001/357/CFSP of 7 May 2001, the Council of the European Union endorsed all measures imposed by the Security Council pursuant to its resolution 1343 (2001). The measures were subsequently implemented by Council Regulation (EC) No. 1146/2001 of 11 June 2001, which entered into force on 13 June 2001.

The Government of Ireland are in the process of enacting appropriate regulatory measures to give effect to the provisions of resolution 1343 (2001). These measures will also supplement the provisions of the regulation of the Council of the European Union, adopted on 11 June 2001, which is binding in its entirety and is directly applicable in Ireland.
