I. Introducción

De conformidad con lo dispuesto en el párrafo 1 del artículo 7 de la Convención sobre la prohibición del empleo, almacenamiento, producción y transferencia de minas antipersonal y sobre su destrucción, cada Estado Parte informará al Secretario General de las Naciones Unidas tan pronto como sea posible, y en cualquier caso no más tarde de 180 días a partir de la entrada en vigor de la Convención para ese Estado Parte, sobre lo estipulado en los apartados a) a i) de dicho párrafo. Además, los Estados Partes actualizarán anualmente esos informes con respecto al año natural precedente, y los presentarán al Secretario General de las Naciones Unidas a más tardar el 30 de abril de cada año (art.7, párr. 2). Con el fin de facilitar esa tarea y de favorecer la comparabilidad y la evaluación de los datos, en mayo de 1999 la Primera Reunión de los Estados Partes aprobó los modelos de formularios de presentación de información, elaborados en consulta con los Estados Partes. En septiembre de 2000, en la Segunda Reunión de los Estados Partes, celebrada en Ginebra, se modificaron los modelos de formularios de presentación de información del artículo 7 añadiendo un modelo adicional "Modelo J: Otras cuestiones pertinentes". Este modelo ofrece a los Estados Partes la oportunidad de informar voluntariamente sobre cuestiones relativas al cumplimiento y la aplicación que no especifican en los requisitos establecidos en el artículo 7 para la presentación de informes, en especial, informar sobre actividades emprendidas con respecto al artículo 6: sobre la asistencia proporcionada para el cuidado y rehabilitación de víctimas de minas, y su integración social y económica¹.

En el presente informe se ofrece una visión general de las respuestas comunicadas por los Estados Partes en los formularios de información al 15 de agosto de 2001. El contenido íntegro de las respuestas puede consultarse en Internet²
