This document contains one paragraph that had been proposed by Brazil at the working group on the draft programme of action at the third session of the Preparatory Committee which the Chairperson of that working group had directed be entered into the draft Programme of Action. This paragraph was inadvertently omitted from document A/CONF.189/5, which contains the draft Programme of Action that was issued for the World Conference, and is reproduced below.

New 68. *Urges* States and non-governmental organizations to acknowledge that individuals who are victims of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance in many cases may also face discrimination based on sexual orientation, and calls upon States, in consultation with competent non-governmental organizations, when appropriate, to develop, implement and improve specific policies and programmes to address this form of multiple discrimination effectively.
