The Permanent Mission of Spain to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia and, in relation to his notes verbales dated 7 June and 27 August 2001 and pursuant to paragraph 18 of Security Council resolution 1343 (2001), in which the Security Council requests all States to report to the Committee established by paragraph 14 of that resolution on the actions they have taken to implement the measures imposed by paragraphs 5 to 7, Spain has the honour to inform him of the following:

With the adoption of its common position 2001/357/PESC, of 7 May 2001, concerning the adoption of restrictive measures against Liberia, the Council of the European Union endorsed all the measures imposed by the Security Council in resolution 1343 (2001). Subsequently, measures were implemented through Council regulation No. 1146/2001, of 11 June 2001, which entered into force on 13 June 2001. As a member State of the European Union, Spain is bound by the abovementioned common position and regulation. The regulation is directly applicable in all the member States, including Spain.
