**Proposal by France concerning regulation 6 contained in  
document PCNICC/2001/L.1/Rev.1/Add.2**

**Regulation 6**

Insert a new paragraph 6.8:

6.8 The trust fund for the benefit of victims of crimes within the jurisdiction of the Court, and of the families of such victims, established by the Assembly of States Parties pursuant to article 79, paragraph 1, shall be funded by, inter alia:

- (a) Resources collected through fines and transferred to the trust fund by order of the Court pursuant to article 79 (2) of the Statute;
- (b) Resources collected through awards for reparations by order of the Court pursuant to rule 98 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;
- (c) Voluntary contributions from Governments, international organizations, individuals, corporations and other entities, in accordance with relevant criteria adopted by the Assembly of States Parties;
- (d) A portion of the Court's financial resources that the Assembly of States Parties may allocate to the fund.

**Note:** This proposal replaces document PCNICC/2000/WGFIRR/DP.33, a proposal submitted by France on 30 November 2000 for the insertion in regulation 6 of a new paragraph 6.2.
