I. Introduction

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 2 of its resolution 54/46 of 1 December 1999, entitled “Verification in all its aspects, including the role of the United Nations in the field of verification”, requested the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its fifty-sixth session on further views received from Member States pursuant to General Assembly resolutions 50/61 of 12 December 1995 and 52/31 of 9 December 1997.
