Subject: Revised rates for telephone and facsimile service using the United Nations global network

- 1. All users of the United Nations global network are advised that staff are responsible for charges incurred using the network and that departments and offices are responsible for collecting charges for personal calls from staff. Departments, offices and staff may wish to keep logs of their calls and copies of internal billing statements, whether personal or official.
- 2. The rates for network services are applied regionally and charged on a perminute basis. They apply to all telephone calls or facsimile transmissions to United Nations duty stations originating from Headquarters and made over the United Nations private network. The current rates are as follows:

Europe	0.06
Asia	0.64
Latin America	0.27
Africa	0.63

3. At present, United Nations private network connections are available to all duty stations on a cost recovery basis. If a call to any duty station is made by dialling the international access code, 011, the Headquarters telephone system will automatically route the call or facsimile transmission over the United Nations private network. In the unlikely event that all of the circuits for a given destination are busy, the call will be automatically routed over commercially available circuits.

- 4. It is also possible to use the United Nations network to place calls to peacekeeping missions and other field locations, which are listed in the annex to the present circular.
- 5. When calls are placed to destinations that are not on the United Nations network, they will be charged to departments and offices at the lowest commercial rate available to the United Nations regardless of the carrier and routing actually used.
- 6. The cost for personal calls, whether over the United Nations global network or routed over commercial circuits, will be recovered by the Executive Office directly from the staff who have placed the calls. Staff are reminded that if a private call has to be routed over commercial circuits, the cost of the call could be higher than if it is placed from the staff member's home telephone, depending on the destination of the call and the long-distance service provider used by the staff member.
