Subject: Celebration of the United Nations Day

- 1. On the occasion of the fifty-sixth anniversary of the signing of the Charter of the United Nations, the State Council of the Republic and Canton of Geneva, the Administrative Council of the City of Geneva, and the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande, are organizing a concert to be held on Wednesday, 24 October 2001 at 8.30 p.m. The Concert will be given at the Victoria Hall by the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande, conducted by Fabio Luisi, with Dame Felicity Lott, soprano.
