**Note verbale dated 26 September 2001 from the Permanent Mission of Bulgaria to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia**

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1343 (2001) concerning Liberia, and has the honour, in addition to its notes of 25 June 2001 and of 14 August 2001 addressed to the Chairman of the Committee, to communicate the following:

1. Measures to implement the sanctions imposed by paragraphs 5 and 6 of resolution 1343 (2001):

With regard to the embargo on exports of arms and related matériel and the provision of technical training related to the provision, manufacture, maintenance or use of such equipment, the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Bulgaria has carried out an examination and has confirmed that the necessary actions were taken to implement the measures imposed under paragraph 5 of resolution 1343 (2001). To date, the Ministry of Interior does not have any information concerning persons or companies carrying out foreign trade activities with Liberia in violation of paragraphs 5 and 6 of resolution 1343 (2001).

2. As regards the list dated 4 June 2001 of individuals designated by the Committee as subject to measure imposed by paragraph 7 of resolution 1343 (2001), the Ministry of Interior does not have any information regarding sojourn authorization by the Bulgarian authorities to persons included in the sanctions committee's list.
