Article 23 bis

Nationals and permanent residents

1. Without prejudice to articles 13, 14, 15, paragraph 6, and 16, paragraph 1, subparagraph (d), a person enjoying immunities and privileges under this Agreement shall not, in the territory of the State Party of which he or she is a national or permanent resident, enjoy exemption from immigration restrictions or alien registration, exemption from inspection of personal baggage, exemption from national service obligations, facilities in respect of currency and exchange, repatriation facilities and exemption of duties and taxes.

2. Other immunities and privileges granted to nationals and permanent residents of a State Party under this Agreement are accorded to the extent necessary for the proper performance of their functions in relation with the Court.
