## **INFORMATION CIRCULAR Nº. 47**

## Subject: Influenza Vaccination

1. The Medical Service has acquired a limited number of doses of influenza vaccine.

2. **Vaccination is advisable** for staff members over 50 years of age and is particularly recommended for those suffering from chronic lung, cardiovascular or kidney disease, from diabetes, and for people convalescing after a severe illness or operation.

3. **It is contra-indicated** in cases of acute infection, treatment with corticosteroids and allergy to eggs, thiomersal or Neomycin. It is not contra-indicated during pregnancy, but it is preferable not to be vaccinated during the first three months of pregnancy unless there is a warning of an epidemic.

4. **Vaccination is available only** to staff members of the Organisation, and not to members of their families, retired staff, delegates or visitors.

5. The vaccination campaign will begin on **Monday 22 October 2001** and will continue for **a period of six weeks.** 

Vaccinations will be performed daily from Monday to Friday

at the Medical Service, Door 2, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. at the Medical Service, E-Building (Room E-3053), from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.

No appointment or prior telephone call is necessary No vaccine will be reserved
