109. Fifty-one years after the establishment of the People's Republic of China, its entire population, including the Tibetan and other minority groups, was enjoying a growing range of economic, social and cultural rights, as well as civil and political rights. The 1.3 billion Chinese people and all unbiased observers recognized that the human rights situation in China was better than ever before. He hoped that the European Union would set aside its prejudices and acknowledge that fact. His Government attached great importance to the positive momentum of the human rights
