Special session of the General Assembly on children

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 55/26 of 20 November 2000, in which it decided to convene the special session of the General Assembly for follow-up to the World Summit for Children from 19 to 21 September 2001, and to refer to it as the “special session on children”,

Recalling also its decision 56/401 of 12 September 2001, by which it decided to postpone the special session of the General Assembly on children to a date to be decided by the General Assembly at its fifty-sixth session,

1. *Decides* to convene the special session of the General Assembly on children from 8 to 10 May 2002;
 2. *Decides also* to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-seventh session an item entitled “Follow-up to the outcome of the special session on children”.
