## **I. STATEMENT OF BASIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES APPLICABLE TO THE VOLUNTARY FUNDS ADMINISTERED BY THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES**

1. The accounts of the voluntary funds administered by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) are maintained in accordance with the Financial Rules for voluntary funds administered by the High Commissioner for Refugees promulgated in 1974 (A/AC.96/503/Rev.1). They are to be submitted to the United Nations Board of Auditors and the Executive Committee of the High Commissioner's Programme.

2. The accounts of the voluntary funds cover the calendar year.

3. Financial transactions are recorded in the accounts on an accrual basis. Thus, all firm pledges (except pledges announced in 1978 for the 1979 general programmes) are recorded as income in 1978 even if they concern programmes whose budgetary period extends into 1979, and therefore may only be obligated in 1979. Likewise, the term "expenditure" designates total obligations incurred up to 31 December 1978 whether liquidated or not. Agreements or letters of instruction signed prior to 31 December 1978 but for projects commencing in 1979 are not included in the 1978 expenditure.

4. The accounts of UNHCR are maintained in United States dollars. Transactions in other currencies are converted into United States dollars at United Nations operational rates of exchange prevailing at the time of the transaction. At year-end, cash, invest-

ments and unpaid pledges are converted at the applicable United Nations rates of exchange.

5. Exchange differences and income from investments are debited/credited to the appropriate funds in accordance with the Financial Rules.

6. Funds at the disposal of the High Commissioner for purposes falling outside the Annual Programme are recorded as trust funds, reserves or special accounts as may be appropriate in accordance with the Financial Rules.

7. The write-off of losses of cash, property or the book value of accounts receivable, including the conversion of loans into grants, are governed by financial rule 10.6. A statement of all amounts written off is submitted to the Board of Auditors with the annual accounts.

8. Non-expendable property purchased out of UNHCR voluntary funds and the ownership of which is vested in UNHCR are charged as expenditure to the appropriate budget accounts in the year of acquisition; they are not included in the balance sheet but are recorded in separate inventories.

9. Short-term investments of monies not immediately required are made in accordance with financial rule 9.1 and a report on such investments is included in the annual accounts.

As a result of our examination, we are of the opinion that the financial statements properly reflect the recorded financial transactions for the year, which were in accordance with the Financial Regulations and legislative authority, and present fairly the financial position as at 31 December 1978.

## IV. REPORT OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

### *Introduction*

1. As required by paragraph 22 of the statute of the Office of the High Commissioner for Refugees, the Board of Auditors has audited the accounts of the voluntary funds administered by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) for the year ended 31 December 1978.

2. The examination was conducted in accordance with article XII of the Financial Regulations and Rules of the United Nations and the annex thereto and with the common auditing standards adopted by the Panel of External Auditors of the United Nations, the Specialized Agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency. The examination was conducted at the UNHCR headquarters at Geneva and at the field offices in Bangladesh, Senegal and Thailand.

3. The normal practice of the Board of Auditors of reporting the results of specific audits was continued during the year under review, with the result that a number of management letters containing detailed audit observations were issued to the Administration. This practice has helped in developing a continuous dialogue with the Administration and is consistent with the Board's new audit approach of applying systems based auditing to all the organizations in the United Nations system for which it has audit responsibility.

4. The Board of Auditors has noted with appreciation the expeditious manner in which the Administration dealt with the matters brought to its notice and the continued efforts being made to improve the financial management and control system of UNHCR. Our observations are intended to assist the Administration in considering and implementing further improvements, and the following are the most significant matters arising from our 1978 audit examination. These matters have been discussed with the Administration whose responses are referred to as appropriate.

### *Procurement system*

5. During 1977, we carried out a review of the newly established Procurement Unit for assistance projects and our observations and recommendations thereon are included in the 1977 Report of the Board of Auditors. We followed up on this review during our 1978 examination and the Internal Audit Division conducted an audit of this area in February 1979. These examinations revealed that savings could be achieved if the procurement function and related activities were more effectively co-ordinated. Internal controls should also be improved. Particular emphasis should be placed on:

(a) The introduction of an annual procurement plan and the early communication and co-ordination of the requirements of the Regional Sections in order to make it possible to negotiate for bulk purchases and thereby achieve savings. At the present time, the Procurement Unit is not being given sufficient notice

of approved procurement projects, and thus it is unable to initiate and complete purchase orders on a timely basis, and to take advantage of bulk purchases of similar items.

(b) The design and introduction of a standard requisition form, and the establishment of procedures for its use and processing. No form is in use at present, with the result that requests are made in memorandum form and frequently do not contain complete information.

(c) The implementation of formal purchase order forms, as we recommended in our 1977 Report.

(d) The development of a system for the proper communication by the field of receipt of purchases, including the introduction of a standard receiving report form. Where confirmation does take place it is usually by cable and generally incomplete.

6. The Administration agreed with our recommendations and informed us that it is in the process of preparing a Manual of Procurement Procedures which will deal with these shortcomings. Moreover, it has already initiated action to obtain confirmations from the field for the receipt of purchases.

### *Outstanding loans*

7. UNHCR provides funds to implementing agencies to be passed on to refugees in the form of loans. Collection of loan repayments is also entrusted to the implementing agencies. The balance in the UNHCR loan accounts at 31 December 1978 amounted to \$13 million.

8. Our examination revealed that the loan accounts had not been reconciled with the agencies; further investigation showed that certain agencies maintain inadequate accounting records of individual loans, and in many cases, loans had to be converted to grants or written off due to inadequate collection procedures.

9. To ensure the reliability of loan accounts, timely collection of loan repayments and to minimize the incidence of write offs, we have recommended to UNHCR that:

(a) Procedures should be established to ensure that agencies submit reports on the status of loans on a regular basis;

(b) Loan accounts should be periodically reconciled with those maintained by the agencies;

(c) Improved follow-up procedures for loan repayments should be instituted.

The Administration agreed with our recommendations and has since taken action to confirm the loan account balances with the agencies.

### *Financial reporting of programme expenditure*

10. Our review of the financial reporting of programme expenditures revealed instances of delays by

implementing agencies in submitting certified final financial statements and narrative reports as required by the relative project agreements. For example, at the time of our review and nine months after completion of one humanitarian aid programme for which UNHCR provided the sum of \$12.35 million, the implementing agency had not submitted the stipulated financial statements and narrative reports. In the circumstances we could not satisfy ourselves that the objectives of the programme had been achieved, that the amount had been used solely for the purposes for which it was provided and that any unused balances had duly been refunded to UNHCR.

11. Furthermore, we were concerned that UNHCR itself was not in a position to monitor activities of this magnitude and recommended that follow-up procedures should be strengthened to ensure that financial reporting of programme expenditures is made by implementing agencies on a more timely basis.

12. The Administration informed us that some of the delays in submission of the certified final financial statements and narrative reports were caused by circumstances beyond the control of the implementing agencies, but that pressure would continue to be brought to bear on the defaulting agencies for their early submission of the reports.

#### *Control of equipment and machinery*

13. UNHCR expects implementing agencies to which non-expendable properties purchased with voluntary funds have been entrusted to exercise adequate controls to ensure their custody, use and maintenance.

14. However, our review of inventory control procedures and the internal audit examination indicated that there is a need for UNHCR to develop and clearly define a policy on ownership, use of equipment and

machinery produced with voluntary funds, and to embody relevant provisions in future implementing instruments.

15. In order to improve UNHCR control over equipment and machinery, we recommended that all future UNHCR agreements which contain an equipment component should provide clear details concerning ownership, insurance coverage, disposal of the equipment upon completion of the project, inventory and reporting requirements, and proper identification of the equipment.

16. The Administration has endorsed the need for a more clearly defined policy on these items and has indicated that it will incorporate appropriate provisions in future agreements.

#### *Comments on matters dealt with in the 1977 report*

17. With the exception of the procurement system upon which we have commented in this report, the Administration has either provided satisfactory explanations or taken appropriate action on the matters raised in the 1977 report.
