LETTER DATED 16 JUNE 1975 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CYPRUS
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to further draw
Your Excellency's attention to the following:

On 14 June 1975, at 0830 hours, an artillery reconnaissance aircraft of the
Turkish Air Force, violated the air space of the Republic of Cyprus by flying
from Pendadactylos to WD 377904, over National Guard positions, and then towards
Pyroi village.

This repeated and systematic violation of the air space of the Republic of
Cyprus by Turkey, causing considerable apprehension and tension in the island, is
a matter that should be given urgent consideration with a view to its
discontinuance.

I would be grateful if this letter were circulated as a document of the
Security Council.
