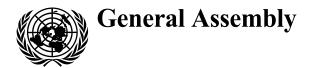

I. Introduction

1. Under agenda item 123, the Fifth Committee considered the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2002-2003. The Committee recommends a gross appropriation of US\$ 2,625,178,700 and an estimate for income (other than income derived from staff assessment) of \$51,757,600. The net expenditure for the biennium 2002-2003 is thus estimated at $$2,573,421,100.^{1}$

2. With regard to the Working Capital Fund, the Fifth Committee recommends that the Fund should be at the level of \$100 million.

3. The Fifth Committee also recommends an estimate of 348,250,300 as staff assessment for transfer in the course of the biennium 2002-2003 to the Tax Equalization Fund, from which credits are distributed to Member States in accordance with General Assembly resolution 973 (X) of 15 December 1955.

4. For its examination of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2002-2003, the Fifth Committee had before it, as basic documents, the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2002-2003 submitted by the Secretary-General,² the first report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2002-2003³ and the reports of the Committee for Programme and Coordination on the work of its forty-first session.⁴ Revised estimates and programme budget implications affecting various appropriation sections were subsequently considered on the basis of reports of the Secretary-General and of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions.

5. In accordance with the guidelines for the contingency fund as annexed to General Assembly resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987, the Fifth Committee, at its 40th meeting, on 24 December 2001, considered a consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates that were subject to the criteria for the use of the contingency fund (A/C.5/56/XX) and the corresponding report of the Advisory Committee, [which was presented orally. The amount fell within the available balance of the contingency fund.] The Fifth Committee, therefore, proceeded to approve the required amount under the relevant section of the programme budget.

6. The general debate on the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2002-2003 was held at the 9th, 12th, 14th, 15th, and 40th meetings, on 15, 17, 19 and 22 October 2001 and 24 December 2001. The debate is reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/56/SR.9, 12, 14, 15 and 40).

7. Introductory statements were made by the Secretary-General, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, and the Chairman of the Committee for Programme and Coordination at the 9th meeting, on 15 October 2001 (see A/C.5/56/SR.9).
