Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

During the week ending 17 November 2001, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Threats to international peace and security caused by terrorist acts (*see* S/2001/15/Add.37 and 39)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4413rd meeting, held on 12 November 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2001/1060), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2001/1060, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1377 (2001) (for the text, see S/RES/1377 (2001); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).



The situation in Afghanistan (see S/1994/20/Add.3, 11, 31 and 47; S/1996/15/Add.6, 14, 38, 41 and 42; S/1997/40/Add.15, 27 and 50; S/1998/44/Add.14, 28, 31, 34, 37 and 49; S/1999/25/Add.33, 40 and 41; S/2000/40/Add. 13 and 50; and S/2001/15/Add.23 and 31; see also S/19420/Add.44; S/20370/Add.14-16; and S/21100/Add.1)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4414th and 4415th meetings, held on 13 and 14 November 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations. There was one suspension and one resumption of the 4414th meeting.

At the 4414th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Afghanistan, Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Canada, Egypt, Germany, India, Indonesia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mexico, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Pakistan, the Republic of Korea, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

At the 4414th meeting, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Lakhdar Brahimi, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Afghanistan.

The meeting was suspended.

Upon resumption of the 4414th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Chile and Turkey, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

At the 4415th meeting, held on 14 November 2001, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Afghanistan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2001/1075), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2001/1075, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1378 (2001) (for the text, see S/RES/1378 (2001); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).

The situation in Burundi (see S/25070/Add.43 and 46; S/1994/20/Add.29, 33, 4 and 50; S/1995/40/Add.4, 9, 12 and 34; S/1996/15 and Add.4, 9, 16, 19, 29, 30 and 34; S/1997/40/Add.21; S/1999/25/Add.44; S/2000/40/Add.2 and 38; and S/2001/15/Add.9, 11, 26, 38, 39, 44 and 45)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4416th (private) and 4417th meetings, held on 15 November 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the 4416th meeting, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council:

“At its 4416th meeting, on 15 November 2001, the Security Council considered the situation in Burundi.

“The Security Council heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by His Excellency Mr. Nelson Mandela, Facilitator of the Arusha Peace Process.

“The Council had a useful exchange of views with His Excellency Mr. Mandela on the Burundi peace process and issues relating to the implementation of the peace agreement.

“The members of the Council thanked His Excellency Mr. Mandela for coming to New York to brief the Council and commended his efforts on behalf of peace in Burundi.”

At the 4417th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Burundi, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2001/35; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4418th and 4419th meetings, held on 15 November 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the 4418th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Angola, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Cape Verde, Malawi, Namibia and Zimbabwe, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Ibrahim Gambari, Under-Secretary-General and Special Adviser of the Secretary-General on Africa.

At the 4419th meeting, the President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2001/36; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).

The situation between Eritrea and Ethiopia (*see* S/1998/44/Add.25; S/1999/25/Add.3, 5 and 7; S/2000/40/Add.18, 19, 30, 32, 36, 45 and 46; and S/2001/15/Add.6, 11, 16, 20 and 37; *see also* S/2001/15/Add.43)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4420th and 4421st private meetings, held on 16 November 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the 4420th meeting, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council:

“At its 4420th meeting, on 16 November 2001, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation between Eritrea and Ethiopia’.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, and with the consent of the Council, the President extended an invitation to His Excellency Mr. Ali Said Abdella, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Eritrea in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The members of the Council and the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Eritrea had a constructive discussion.”

At the close of the 4421st meeting, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council:

“At its 4421st meeting, held in private on 16 November 2001, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation between Eritrea and Ethiopia’.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, and with the consent of the Council, the President extended an invitation to His Excellency Mr. Seyoum Mesfin, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Ethiopia in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The members of the Council and the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Ethiopia had a constructive discussion.”
