The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4433rd meeting, held on 5 December 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Mission in Bosnia and Herzegovina (S/2001/1132 and Corr.1).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Belgium and Bosnia and Herzegovina, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Hédi Annabi, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4434th meeting, held on 6 December 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the letter dated 5 December 2001 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2001/1154).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Afghanistan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2001/1153) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2001/1153 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1383 (2001) (for the text, see S/RES/1383 (2001); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).

"On 7 December 2001, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, section A of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 4435th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).

"The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Joachim Hütter, Director of Europe and Latin America Division of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.

"The members of the Council had a constructive exchange of views with representatives of participating troop-contributing countries."
