LETTER DATED 31 AUGUST 1988 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces.

- 1. Between 5:00 and 6:00 hours, on 23 August 1988, Iraqi forces raised the Iraqi flag and set up watch guards to the rear of Iranian forces in the village of Hassanabad at the geographic co-ordinates of 90400-36600 on the map of Panjvin.
- 2. At midnight, on 26 August 1988, an Iranian bulldozer was stolen by Iraqi forces from the geographic co-ordinates of 9500-37600 and taken to Iraqi territory.
- 3. On 27 August 1988, Iraqi forces raised the Iraqi flag on the 1500 Height in the Suren Heights at the geographic co-ordinates of 90-3500.
- 4. At 01:00 hours, on 27 August 1988, Iraqi forces fired approximately 6 bullets in the Gamrag Haj Omran area.
- 5. At 14:45 hours, on 27 August 1988, a number of counter-revolutionary elements, accompanied by Iraqi forces, entered Iranian territory in Sardasht through the geographic co-ordinates of 39-41 on the 1:50,000 map of Sardasht. This led to confrontation and exchange of fire between forces, which injured an Iranian military personnel.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
