UNITED NATIONS COMPENSATION COMMISSION GOVERNING COUNCIL

> Decision concerning part two of the ninth instalment of individual claims for damages above USD 100,000 (category "D" claims) taken by the Governing Council of the United Nations Compensation Commission at its 113th meeting, held on 13 December 2001

The Governing Council,

<u>Having received</u>, in accordance with article 38 of the Provisional Rules for Claims Procedure ("the Rules"), the report and recommendations made by the "D1" panel of Commissioners concerning part two of the ninth instalment of individual claims for damages above USD 100,000 (category "D" claims), covering 278 claims, $\underline{1}/$

1. <u>Approves</u> the recommendations made by the panel of Commissioners, and, accordingly,

2. <u>Decides</u>, pursuant to article 40 of the Rules, to approve the amounts of the recommended awards concerning the claims covered in the report. The aggregate amounts per country or international organization, based on the recommendations contained in the annex of the report, are as follows:

3. <u>Notes</u> that, as referred to in paragraph 2 of the report, no recommendation has been made for 21 claims that were deferred to a later instalment of category "D" claims, and for two claims that were transferred to a different panel of Commissioners,

4. <u>Reaffirms</u> that when funds become available payments shall be made in accordance with decision 100 (S/AC.26/Dec.100 (2000)),

5. <u>Recalls</u> that when payments are made in accordance with decision 100 and pursuant to the terms of decision 18 (S/AC.26/Dec.18 (1994)), the Governments and international organizations shall distribute amounts received to the designated claimants in respect of approved awards within six months of receiving payment, and shall, not later than three months after the expiration of this time limit, provide information on such distribution,

6. <u>Requests</u> the Executive Secretary to provide a copy of the report to the Secretary-General, to the Government of the Republic of Iraq and to each respective Government and international organization.
