Working Party on Road Traffic Safety (Thirty-eighth session, 19-22 March 2002, agenda item 4 (b))

PROPOSALS REGARDING THE HOLDING OF THE FOURTH ROAD SAFETY WEEK

In accordance with the decisions of the Working Party on Road Traffic Safety at its thirty-seventh session (10-14 September 2001), it is planned to hold the fourth Road Safety Week in 2004. The Russian Federation proposes that the Week should be devoted to issues of traffic and pedestrian safety during hours of darkness, with the motto: "Safety after dark".

During the campaign, attention must be focused on the following areas:

- 1. Checking the use of exterior lights on vehicles during the hours of darkness;
- 2. Use of reflective materials on vehicles and the garments of pedestrians and in controlling traffic;
- 3. Lighting of streets and roads, pavements and cycle tracks;
- 4. Ensuring that drivers are complying with the restrictions on their work during the hours of darkness.
