

## Enclosure, paragraph 3, subparagraphs (b) and (c)

The subparagraphs concerning international legal instruments should read:

- International Convention for the Suppression of the Financing of Terrorism, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 9 December 1999.
  Burundi signed the Convention on 13 November 2001;
- Organization of African Unity (OAU) Convention on the Prevention and Combating of Terrorism. Burundi signed the Convention on 14 July 1999;
- Protocol for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts of Violence at Airports Serving International Civil Aviation, concluded at Montreal on 24 February 1988.
  Burundi has not signed the Protocol but acceded to it by Decree-Law No. 1/011 of 6 June 1998;
- International Convention for the Suppression of Terrorist Bombings, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 15 December 1997. Burundi signed the Convention on 4 March 1998;
- Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation, concluded at Montreal on 23 September 1971. Burundi acceded to the Convention by Decree-Law No. 1/011 of 6 June 1998;
- Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft, signed at The Hague on 16 December 1970. Burundi acceded to the Convention on 6 June 1998;
- Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft, signed at Tokyo on 14 September 1963. Burundi signed the Convention on 14 July 1971 and deposited its instrument of ratification with ICAO on 12 October 1971;

 Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes against Internationally Protected Persons, including Diplomatic Agents, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations in New York on 14 December 1973.
Burundi acceded to the Convention on 17 December 1980.
