UNITED NATIONS COMPENSATION COMMISSION GOVERNING COUNCIL

> Decision concerning part one of the third instalment of "F3" claims taken by the Governing Council of the United Nations Compensation Commission at its 115th meeting, held on 13 March 2002

The Governing Council,

<u>Having received</u>, in accordance with article 38 of the Provisional Rules for Claims Procedure ("the Rules"), the report and recommendations made by the panel of Commissioners concerning part one of the third instalment of "F3" claims, covering 15 claims, 1/

1. <u>Approves</u> the recommendations made by the panel of Commissioners, and, accordingly,

2. <u>Decides</u>, pursuant to article 40 of the Rules, to approve the amounts of the recommended awards concerning the claims covered in the report. The aggregate amount awarded, based on the recommendations contained in table 17 of the report, is as follows:

3. <u>Reaffirms</u> that when funds become available payments shall be made in accordance with decision 100 (S/AC.26/Dec.100 (2000)),

4. <u>Recalls</u> that when payments are made in accordance with decision 100, and pursuant to the terms of decision 18 (S/AC.26/Dec.18 (1994)), the Government of the State of Kuwait shall distribute amounts received to the designated claimants in respect of approved awards within six months of receiving payment, and shall, not later than three months after the expiration of this time limit, provide information on such distribution,

5. <u>Requests</u> the Executive Secretary to provide a copy of the report to the Secretary-General, to the Government of the Republic of Iraq and to the Government of the State of Kuwait.
