**Security Council Committee established
pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999)****Note verbale dated 16 April 2002 from the Permanent Mission of
the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the
Chairman of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999), and referring to the Committee's request in resolution 1390 (2002) in particular, paragraphs 2, 6 and 8, has the honour to provide the following according to the information received from the Syrian authorities.

1. There has never been any relationship between the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic and the Taliban and Al-Qaida organizations and other individuals, groups, undertakings and entities associated with them.
2. There are no accounts or any financial assets for those individuals and groups in the Syrian Arab Republic.
3. The Syrian Government prevents the entry into, or transit through, its territories of those individuals or groups.
4. The Syrian Government prevents the direct and indirect supply, sale and transfer of arms and related materials of all types of weapons and ammunitions to those individuals and groups.
5. The Permanent Mission of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations will provided the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) with any new information on the subject.
